There is a limited number of sentences on each page, so that children can enjoy the pictures and either read the book themselves, read it with help, or have the book read to them, depending on their age and reading ability. The main part of the book talks about the ruby-throated humming bird, but there is a section near the back that briefly describes some of the hummingbirds found on the west coast and in southern states.
