Based on a poem The Language of Us and Them (Shevin, 1987), The Power of Words combines words, pictures, and music to present examples of how the 149 talk about the 1 with autism, noting that even well-meaning and kind words can set the tone for acceptance or rejection as well as for inclusion or exclusion. While acknowledging the importance of a proper diagnosis, Judy warns about the damage and pain labeling can cause by separating and isolating. This powerful DVD inspires us to use language wisely.
